

Chung Yuan Christian University, College of Humanities and Education, Excellent Teachers Selection Regulations

Approved at the 99th College Affairs Meeting on October 6, 1999

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Revised at the 102nd College Affairs Meeting on February 18, 2014

Article 1

These regulations are established in accordance with Article 1 of the "Selection Regulations for Excellent Teachers at Chung Yuan Christian University."

Article 2

Teachers who are of good character, fulfill the requirements of the school, and hold a position of lecturer or above may be recommended as candidates if they meet the following conditions:

1. They must have taught at the university for at least three years at the time of recommendation.
2. They continually strive to improve their teaching materials and methods, demonstrating outstanding teaching results.
3. They show a serious attitude toward their career and in the development and guidance of students.
4. They strictly adhere to the school's teaching regulations.

Article 3

The method for recommending a teacher to be considered an Excellent Teacher:

1. Those nominated to become an Excellent Teacher must have strong evaluation results from the past three years.
2. The number of recommendations from each department (institute, center) will be determined according to the ratio of full-time faculty positions.
3. Candidates will be recommended first by the department (institute, center) or through special selection committees for Excellent Teachers.
4. The number of candidates recommended to the university will be based on the quotas approved and announced by the university.
5. Recommended candidates from each department (institute, center) must provide relevant materials to the selection committee within the stipulated timeframe to participate in the university-wide selection for Excellent Teachers.

Article 4

This college will establish a selection committee for Excellent Teachers, consisting of seven to thirteen members. The dean is an *ex officio* member and will serve as the convener. Half of the committee must be comprised of members who have previously been selected an Excellent Teacher, with one of these members being from outside of this college.

Article 5

For meetings of the Selection Committee for Excellent Teachers in this college to convene, two-thirds of all members must be present. Nominations must be approved by two-thirds of the attending members to be passed. Voting will be conducted anonymously.

Article 6

Teachers in this college who have been selected as university-level Excellent Teachers will not be eligible to be nominated again for the two years after their third consecutive selection.

Article 7

The Excellent Teachers selected will receive a certificate and trophy presented at the annual banquet. The college will publicly recognize those awarded with the "Good Teacher" certificate at appropriate occasions.

Article 8

These regulations shall be implemented after being approved by the College Affairs Meeting.
